The Executive Committee (referred as EXCO hereafter) of the Wah Yan College Kowloon Past Students' Association Limited (referred as PSA hereafter) for the session 2009-2010 was elected on 6th June 2009 at International Function Room, 5/F, The Cityview, 23 Waterloo Road, Kowloon, Hong Kong (formerly known as YMCA International House).

With much enthusiasm and efforts from both EXCO and non-EXCO members of the PSA, the PSA successfully organized a variety of activities and projects as reported herein.

Members Development

The scope of Members Development was overseen by Billy Wong who was responsible for coordinating the work of four sub-committees, namely Student Members Committee, Young Members Committee, Interest Committee and Old Boys' Choir Committee. Members recruitment was conducted at both F.5 and F.7 Graduation Dinners. Results were encouraging.

Student Members Committee (SMC)

Benjamin So served as chairman of the SMC.

Member recruitment was conducted at the Form 5 and Form 7 Graduation Dinners. Around 70% of the matriculate graduates signed up for membership, and their contacts were consolidated.

The Committee organized a JUPAS talk and a mock interview session at WYK so as to help current students go through the admission process of different institutions. Regular alumni gatherings at universities were held. It is hoped that the upcoming session could extend the reach of the alumni network to all tertiary institutions.

SMC also played an active role in assisting other committees in a range of functions, most notably at the Homecoming Concert, the Walkathon, and the Wah Yan Soccer League. A few SMC executives have also taken up to perform in Wah Yan Encore as a tribute to Wah Yan.

Young Members Committee (YMC)

Raymond Siu and Miro Ng served as the Joint Chairmen of the YMC this year.

Assistance in Wah Yan Walkathon 2009

The YMC has arranged its members to assist in the Walkathon 2009, which was held on 18 October 2009.

Assistance in Wah Yan Graditude Dinner 2009

The YMC has arranged its members to assist in the Gratitude Dinner 2009, which was held on 13 December 2009.

YMC Dinner

A dinner for YMC Members is held on 22 May 2010 at 家宴廚藝.

Co-ordination with PSA EXCO

In order to enhance the communication between PSA EXCO and the YMC and the continuity of PSA EXCO, some current executives of the YMC have been nominated to the PSA EXCO for the coming year. It is expected that the executives of YMC will continue to contribute to the development of PSA after their retirement from the YMC.

Interest Group Committee

Albert Leung and Tom Ho served as the Joint Chairmen of the Professional Interest Group Committee. Professional interest groups such as accounting, legal & financial services, medical, astronomy and Tai Chi & Kung Fu were in operation. Various gatherings have been organized throughout the year to promote the interest and strengthen the bonding among the members of the respective interest groups.

Old Boys' Choir (OBC)

In 2008, the PSA organised a group of old boys, mostly former school choir members, to

make a choir performance at the Homecoming Concert 2008. The group comprised of past students across a wide different generations – graduates from the 70s to recent time. The performance was not only a great success but also an indication of the strong interest and desire of our old boys to continue the choir tradition of WYK and the joy of choral singing. In view of this, the PSA endorsed the OBC as an interest group in the same year. Since then, the OBC has performed in a number of PSA or school functions and has expanded its reach to more and more past students. This year, considering the scale of the OBC's operation, the PSA passed the resolution in April to adopt the OBC as a sub-committee.

Over the past year, the OBC performed at the Homecoming Concert 2009 on 5 September. At the event, the OBC not only performed by itself but also cooperated with the WYK Choir to make a joint performance and worked with the Past Student Choir of Good Hope School in delivering a mixed choir performance.

On 13 December, the OBC performed at the Gratitude Dinner organised by the PSAs of the two Wah Yan's in celebration of the 85/90 anniversary of the two schools.

In April this year, the OBC was invited by the WYK Music Association ("MA") to join as a guest and record two songs in the music album "Let it Shine!" which is being produced by the MA at the moment.

Mike Cheng served as the chairman of the OBC.

Members Service

The scope of members service was overseen by Alvin Chan and Raymond Siu who were responsible for coordinating the work of four sub-committees, namely Sports Committee, Wah Yan Plus Card Committee, Social Services Committee and F1 Admission Committee.

Sports Committee

Same as previous two years, Sport Committee has organized both the Wah Yan Soccer League ("the Soccer League") and the Wah Yan Joint-PSA Basketball League Tournament ("the Basketball League"). Due to an unexpected football pitch repair work consequent on the landslide at WYK, the Soccer League could only start on 30th January 2010. Therefore, kick-off match of this year was being deferred for at least two months and the season period is being shortened inevitably by way of having scheduled the matches both on Saturdays and Sundays. This year there are 21 teams participating in and the final match is expected to be held in the middle of May if the weather allows. On the other hand, for the Basketball League, there are eight teams contending for the champion of this year. Because of unfavourable weather in spring, the final match day, which was originally scheduled on 20th March 2010, has now been pending and is then being rescheduled in May. This season is the last year of

Wah Yan Plus Card Committee

It was recorded by the end of 2009 there were around 500 alumni enrolled to the Wah Yan Plus Card. A lot of effort is required to promote the card and recruit new members. The operation of the Plus Card is subject to an overall review and revamp in the forthcoming year.

Social Services Committee

In this executive year, Nigel Chan is the chairman of the Social Service Sub-committee. The committee cooperate with The Boys' and Girls' Clubs Association of Hong Kong Tin Shui Wai Centre for the children with developmental difficulties. We had organized 5 activities with the Tin Shui Wai Centre. Besides, the committee is looking for other opportunities to cooperate with other charity organizations such as WYOFF and Tzuchi (慈濟).

F1 Admission Committee

The work was taken up by Lau Wai Hung and Mike Cheng to help the past students who are going to send their sons to the School.

In January and February 2010, the names of the students were gathered with the help from Mr. Keung Yiu Ming. Contacts were made to the past students by sending mass e-mails. The potential candidates were then contacted by telephone and e-mails. A talk was given to the past students on the evening of 26th February 2010. The talk was given by Lau Wai Hung with inputs from Mike Cheng and Cecil Chung. Mr. Keung Yiu Ming helped in the arrangement of the talk. The talk was attended by 11 past students. Three of the spouses of the past students also came. There were two or three who planned to send their sons to the school in 2011 or later. The audience was satisfied with the arrangement as shown by an evaluation questionnaire. The consensus was that similar talks should be organized in future.

Secretariat

This is a setup headed by the Honorary Secretary, which aimed to provide a more comprehensive secretariat support to the Exco and groom prospects for the succession purpose. Angus Lee, Eric Fan and Oscar Leung proved to be valuable assets to the Secretariat and contributed greatly to its smooth operation.

IT Management Committee

The objective of I.T. Committee is WYKPSA is responsible for official web site. From March

2. Golden Jubliee of Ordination of Fr. Deignan, S.J.

A Mass and tea party was held on 7 Nov 2009 to celebrate the Golden Jubliee of Ordination of our beloved Fr. Deignan, S.J. at WYHK.

3. School Anniversary Walkathon

On 18 Oct 2009, the two Wah Yans kicked off the 85th and 90th anniversaries celebrations of WYK and WYHK respectively with the Pace with Love – 2009 Wah Yan Walkathon. There were close to 1,800 people participating in the event including walkers, helpers and officers. Many past students, current students, teachers, staff and their families and friends came to celebrate our schools' Big Day! Hon. Donald Tsang, the Chief Executive, as the Guest of Honor, Fr. Provincial, and other VIP's including Fathers and past students were invited to officiate the Opening Ceremony. The event has raised close to HK\$880,000 for both Wah Yans. Although fund raising was not the key element for the anniversaries celebration, many current and past students and parents were actively supporting the event by making decent contributions, which indeed can help both schools grow stronger and healthier. 7. Mentorship Scheme

The programme was initiated after a discussion of the School Management Committee on 20th March 2009.

The objectives of the programme are:-

- a. Enhance your mentee's educational and personal growth through inspiration, motivation, and role-modeling.
- b. Broaden the exposure of your mentee by bringing a variety of life experiences to the relationship.

The programme aimed to provide help to the cohort of students studying at F4 and continued through their year of F5. The Past Students Association took up the programme in April. Lau Wai Hung was appointed to be the co-ordinator. Mentors were recruited via mass e-mails as well as personal contacts. Initially more than 100 past students were willing to be mentors. Mentees were recruited through the school - class teachers and guidance committee. A total of 80 students applied for the programme.

In the planning of the programme, Prof. Hau Kit Tai (educational psychologist), Mr. Kevin Ko and Mr. Joseph Lau (clinical psychologist) were involved. Mr. J. Lau continued to give valuable input and was a mentor in the programme. Mr. Alex Ng, Boris Chan (Guidance Committee), Mr. Matthew Chu, Ms. Pat Chan (psychologists) were involved in the planning of the programme. Valuable input was given by Dr. John Tan, Mr. Keung Yiu Ming and the

class teachers of the F4 classes.

Two training sessions (29 May and 6 June) were organized for the mentors and matching with the mentees was subsequently done. The sessions were taken up by Mr. Matthew Chu and Ms. Pat Chan. A total of 94 (52+42) past students attended the sessions. Eighty of them were chosen and matched with the mentees. A briefing for the mentees was held on 19th June.

A kick off ceremony was held on 4 July. The ceremony was officiated by Dr. Tan. Over 60 mentors and 50 mentees came to the occasion to meet each other.

The mentors and mentees are divided into ten groups for easier communication. They then try to develop on their own. One group has tried to organize group activity. Evaluation of the programme was done on 18th and 19th September with feedback and comments from the mentors. A total of 35 mentors came to the meetings. Most mentors were able to keep some degree of communication with their mentees.

A workshop on preparation of HKCE was held on 21 November 2009. The talk was given by Jeff Sze (class of 2003). It was attended by about a dozen students. Another talk on altenative pathways was held on 28 November 2009 by George Leung (class of 1977) and Eric Lai (class of 1997). The attendance was poor and the talk turned out to be a discussion between the speaker and the career master and the mentors.

Evaluation was done through questionnaires in early 2010 with the mentees. The overall response to the programme was positive. Although some mentors have difficulty in getting into contact with the mentees, most of the pairs maintain good relationship. Over 90 percent of the mentee were satisfied with the programme. Further evaluation was done by Mr. Aslan Yu, assistant social worker of the school.

The programme will continue till October 2010.
