The redevelopment project of grass football pitch will be completed before September, an opening mass and would be conducted in mid-September. A friendly football match would be followed by the opening mass!



An Accident Involving an Alumnus

Ho Chun To, Ronald, 何鎮濤 graduate of class 2002, and his wife Priscilla, were seriously injured in a serious car crash at the countryside of Christchurch in New Zealand while on their honeymooon in Sept 2013. They were trapped in the rented car and luckily saved in time by a farmer passing by. Ronald had a broken leg while his wife suffered more serious injuries, including acute traumatic brain injury and multiple fractures of the spine and the limb bones, She was admitted into the ICU of Christchurch Hospital. Multiple surgical procedures were performed by different surgical specialists - neurosurgeons, general surgeons orthopaedic surgeons and maxillo-facial surgeons. She was finally discharged from hospital in May 2014. Flying back from New Zealand in late June, she was admitted to Queen Mary Hospital and subsequently MacLehose Medical Rehabilitation Centre. She is now on a long course of slow recovery.

Deeply touched by all supports of sincerity, Ronald would like to express his thanks and gratitude to everyone involved in helping out, financially or spiritually. He also appreciates all medical advice and experience sharing during the difficult moments over the last few months.


Photographic Exhibition of an Alumnus
