Dear teachers, parents, Wahyanites and friends of Wah Yan,

Fund-raising Campaign 2016-17 for Fr. Kelly Educational Fund Ltd.

Each year, Fr. Kelly Educational Fund Ltd. appropriates more than HK\$1.5 million for supporting our students to take part in a variety of learning activities, but it is envisaged that the sponsorship can only be sustained for three more years. We are launching a fund-raising campaign and we have set a target of HK\$10 million for the upcoming fund-raising activities.

The overarching theme of our campaign is “**Growth from Unity; Rooted in Experience**” (根·緣). With the support of the whole Wah Yan community, we can grow beyond excellence, and our unity is rooted in the school experience that we share at Wah Yan, where we belong and take pride in.

Background

Fr. Kelly Educational Fund Ltd. is a trust fund set up in 1988 by a group of alumni of Wah Yan College, Kowloon, in honour of their former Form-master Fr. James Kelly, who was a Jesuit priest teaching at Wah Yan in the 50's and 60's. The fund was established for the purposes of providing bursaries or financial assistance for the students of Wah Yan College, Kowloon, sponsoring scholarships, music vocal masterclasses, orchestra and choral music camps, overseas music tours, sports training, life-planning workshops, overseas exchange and service programmes, Information Technology development, community building activities, improvement of school facilities, to name but a few. With the sponsorship, Wahyanites can enjoy different learning experiences, broadening their horizon, polishing their skills and developing a vision to be better “Men for and with Others”. The Fund is managed by a management committee which consists of Jesuit fathers, the incumbent Principal and Vice Principal, the Emeritus Principal and Vice Principals, and alumni.

Gratitude - Homecoming Concert 2016

The Gratitude - Homecoming Concert 2016 is our first fund-raising event, which aims to gather generations of Wahyanites to converge on our Waterloo Road campus and revel in our fond nostalgic memories for performing and singing on stage in the school hall. Wall of Shields




