The "Student Ambassador Scheme"

Objective

The objective of the "Student Ambassador Scheme" is to recognize students of Wah Yan College Kowloon who possess the following qualities:

1. Impeccable personality and conduct;
2. A passion to continually serve the WYK Past Students' Association and the Wah Yan community at large;
3. Being a role model for Wahyanites;
4. A man for and with others.

Scope

The scheme is open to all F.5 students studying at Wah Yan College Kowloon. Each academic year, up to three students may be selected as winners of the "WYK Past Students' Association Award". One of the winners of the "WYK Past Students' Association Award" will be selected as the "Student Ambassador" by WYK Past Students' Association.

The Selection Panel

The Selection Panel will be responsible for shortlisting, evaluating and selecting award winners.

The membership of the Selection Panel comprises the Chairman, the Vice-chairmen, the Honourary Secretary, the Honourary Treasurer of Wah Yan College Kowloon Past Students' Association (WYKPSA) and a minimum of two Executive Council members of WYKPSA appointed by the Chairman.

Selection Process and Criteria

(A) Self-nomination

The application is based on self-nomination. It takes into account the students' commitment to the Wah Yan community.

To be qualified as a candidate of the "Student Ambassador Scheme", he shall submit a completed application form together with a full C.V., his F. 4 report card and 20 nominations from his fellow F.5 schoolmates.

(B) Selection of Recipients of the “WYK Past Students’ Association Award” and the “Student Ambassador”

The Selection Panel will shortlist up to three qualified candidates to attend an interview and select up to three winners of the “WYK Past Students’ Association Award”. The most outstanding student will be appointed the “Student Ambassador”. Selection criteria are as follows: -

- (i) His performance in the interview session;
- (ii) His achievements over the years;
- (iii) His overall performance in several areas, including, but not limited to, evaluations on the supporting documents and application forms provided by the candidates, his personalities and communication skills, achievements and the roles he has played in various events and extracurricular activities;
- (iv) His commitment to continue to serve Wah Yan College Kowloon Past Students’ Association and the Wah Yan community at large.

The Awards

The awards are intended to serve as a motivator for continuous improvements. Each recipient of the “WYK Past Students’ Association Award” will receive a scholarship of HK\$1,000, and an additional HK\$3,000 for the “Student Ambassador”.

On top of that, the “Student Ambassador” will be invited to visit an overseas chapter of WYKPSA during summer with financial subsidies.

The results will be announced in the school’s Speech Day.

All candidates of the “Student Ambassador Scheme” have the right to withdraw at any stage of the selection.

In the event that the Selection Panel considers that no candidate possesses the required qualities or there is no valid nominated candidate, the Selection Panel is entitled not to grant any award to anyone.

The Selection Panel is entitled to exercise its reasonable discretion to disqualify or withdraw an award before, during or after the selection process if any candidate or winner has engaged in any activity which the Selection Panel considers to have caused an unacceptable reduction of his



prestige as a Wahyanite or brings the Wah Yan community in disrepute.
