



The 53rd Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Wah Yan College Kowloon Past Students' Association (WYKPSA) was held on 24 June 2023 (Saturday) at the School Hall. The meeting started at 3 pm and was attended by over 80 alumni, graduates ranging from the 1950s to 2020s. This is the most well attended AGM in the recent years.

We were honoured to have Fr. Clement Tsui, the School Supervisor, and Ms. Cecilia Chow, the Principal, with us. In the election of the executive committee, over 770 votes were casted, creating the record. The counting of votes went on beyond 8 pm and the result of the election was announced by 8:40 pm. 40 members of the Executive Committee for the term of office 2023-2024 were elected.

The Oral History Project

The Heritage Centre Project

Under the leadership of Keung Yiu Ming (WYK'75), the Heritage Centre serves as a site for heritage items of historical as well as sentimental values to the school and the Wah Yan community at large, where visitors are able to interact with the past, present and future.


