The concert featured an array of performances, showcasing the diverse talents of both past and present students, from classical pieces to contemporary music.

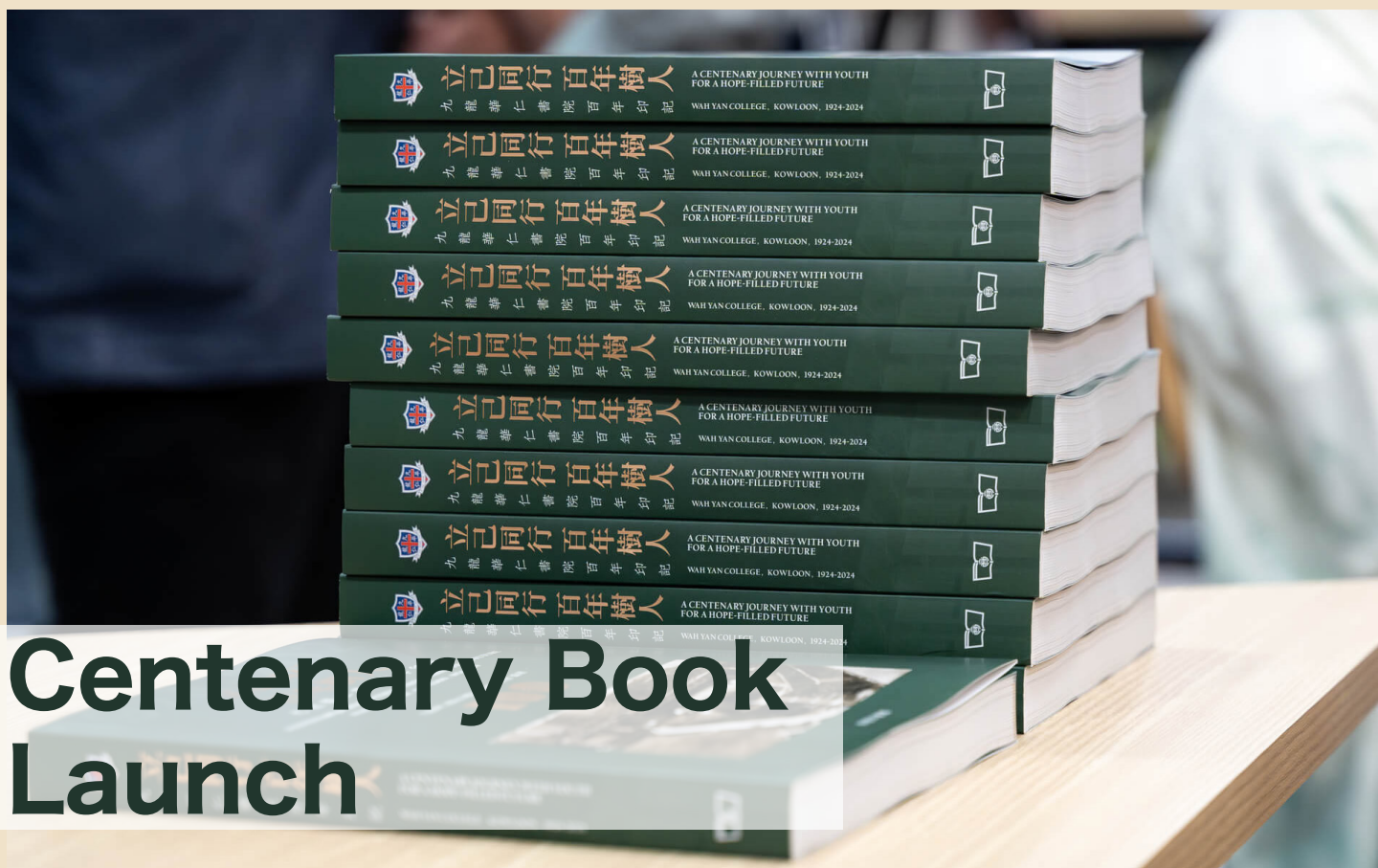
