Fr. Zee Chi-chung, George, S.J. went to the Lord peacefully on 14th June 2025 at Saint Teresa Hospital, Hong Kong at 11:26 pm.

Fr. Zee was born in Shanghai, China on 23rd August 1940. He entered the Society at Cheung Chau, Hong Kong on 7th September 1960; was ordained to the priesthood at Wah Yan College Kowloon on 3rd December 1972, and professed the final vows on 8th September 1980 at Wah Yan College Kowloon.

All priests of the Chinese Province are to celebrate one Mass first intention for Fr. Zee's eternal rest. Those who are not priests are to offer one Mass and Communion and recite one "corona". The members of Matteo Ricci Community in Hong Kong are to offer two Masses, etc.

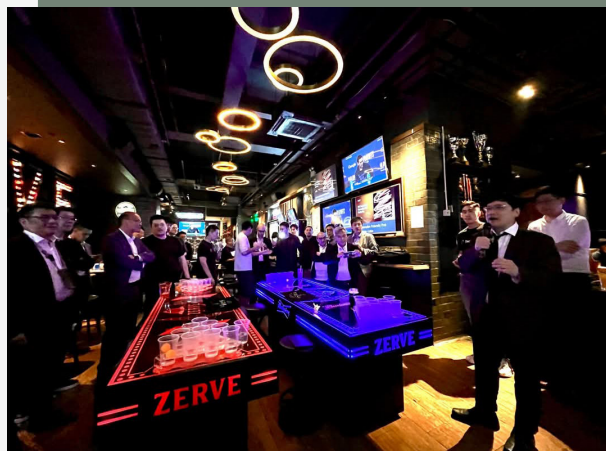
The Innovation Fraternity also remember our young boys and students who need advice and insights for career planning and laying their future paths.
