We were honored to invite our school principal Ms. Cecilia Chow, Mr. Mo Yuen, former member of the Hong Kong handball team and current fitness coach, Joshua Li (Class of 2010) and Ares Shum (Class of 2015), two professional physiotherapists to join the seminar.

Ms. Chow delivered the opening speech, encouraging everyone to view long-distance running as a lifelong journey of self-improvement, sharing her personal experience of progressing from 10 kilometers to a half marathon.
